 Wife's contribution: 4% of 4,000
 $= \frac{4}{100} \times 4,000 = \text{N}160$
 Total contribution = N385 + N160

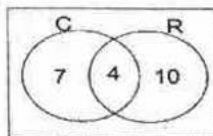
